



First, use the marquee tool to select most of the background.




Then press shift + F5 (or Edit -> Fill) to bring up the fill dialog box. Fill the background appropriately (in this case white). The result should look something like this.




Next, use the magic wand tool to select the dark text.

Make sure the "contiguous" box is unchecked and adjust the tolerance as necessary.




Then press ctrl+shift+i (or Select -> Inverse) to select everything <u>except</u> the dark text. Use shift+F5 (or Edit -> Fill) to again bring up the fill dialog box and fill the remaining background with white. The result should look something like this.




If you zoom in, you'll notice there are still lots of little dark dots around the text that need to be eliminated.

 Press ctrl+D (or click off the canvas) to deselect the canvas. Then, open the Dust & Scratches Filter dialog box under Filter -> Noise -> Dust & Scratches



Adjust the Radius and Threshold options until most of the unwanted dark spots disappear, but the text is still mostly clean and legible, then press OK.






The result will look something like this.

Clean up any remaining dark spots using the dodge, clone stamp, or brush tools.


41217.16450 59067.90610 41217.17717 CP #30 59067.89897 0.000000 The Dust & Scratches filter made the text a little blurry.



Fix this by opening the Unsharp Mask Filter under Filter -> Sharpen -> Unsharp Mask.



Adjust the Amount, Radius, and Threshold levels until the text becomes crisp and clear.
